#655 Light Ash

Light Ash (#655) is a beautiful taupe blonde that is excellent for fair to medium skin tones (Fitzpatrick 1-3). For a fairer blonde add Butterscotch #120 to warm and neutralize. Add Butternut #115 to lighten.

Rose Marie's Tips:

Eyebrows Be generous when warming these new shades due to the concentration

Correcting orange brows

Light Ash is the answer if brows are too warm. You will want to use Light Ash straight. I would suggest using a 5-shader throughout the brow to correct the color. After healing you can add movement with hair strokes using either the 4-flat or 3-outliner needles.

Creating a powdery eyebrow

When you need a soft, powdery eyebrow use the 5-shader or 7-liner needles. I would recommend setting your device speed at 130.

Lighter Brow Shades: I add 1-3 drops of Butterscotch to my formula.

Mid-Range Brow Shades: I add 2-4 drops of butterscotch to my formula. I add a few drops of Henna if I want some warmth.

Deeper Brown Brow Shades: I add at least 4 drops of Butterscotch along with 2-4 drops of Henna, if I want to retain some warmth.
