



## PRE-PROCEDURE FORM

**Contraindications for Procedure – Please be aware if any of these conditions exist, our practitioners will not be able to complete your procedure.**

- Are you currently under a doctor's care for any condition?
- Do you require any pre-medication for any procedures?
- Pregnant or Nursing
- Chemotherapy and Radiation full treatments: Prophylactic chemotherapy is generally safe to proceed
- Any active rashes, breakouts, open sores or fever blisters anywhere on your face?
- Active case of rosacea, eczema, psoriasis or any skin condition.
- Sick with flu/fever.

### Require Waiting Periods

- ✓ **Eyelash extensions must be removed 1-2 days prior to eyeliner**
- ✓ **Contact Lenses must be removed prior to an eyeliner procedure (bring your glasses with you)**
- If not happy with results, let product run its 3-month cycle*
- Lasik - Cataract Surgery – 1 month prior and wait *3 months post-op*
- Sty or Chalazion – wait 2 wks. from time of healing
- Latisse or any other eyelash enhancement products (including mascaras) ~ minimum 2 weeks off
  - *(Causes excessive bleeding, sensitivity, bruising and color may not be retained).*
- Botox or Disport – 1 Day since they cannot lie flat for at least 5 hours
- Fillers (i.e. Juvaderm, Silk, Voluma, Sculptra, etc.) – 1 week
- Fat transfer in lips – wait 1 -2 months for swelling to subside
- Accutane full dose – 1 year (half-dose or prophylactic dose needs medical clearance)
- Topical Acne Cream – Benzoyl Peroxide, Clindamycin, Pro-Active – 1 week
- Suntanned skin – 1 month
- Retinols, glycolic acid (A.H.A), Vitamin C peels – 4 weeks
- Laser resurfacing – 8 weeks
- IPL (Intense Pulsed Light) – 2-weeks post
- Laser used to remove old permanent makeup – 8 weeks

### Require Medical Clearance/Pre-Medication

- Eye Diseases (i.e. Glaucoma or Graves' Disease) – medical clearance
- Heart valves, all stents, titanium rods, screws, pacemakers, rheumatic fever – medical clearance and pre-medication
- Organ transplants – medical clearance and pre-medication
- Joint replacements – medical clearance and pre-medication
- Insulin dependent diabetics – medical clearance and pre-medication
- Fever blister history – medical clearance and pre-medication min. 2-days prior and 4-days post
- Shingles history – medical clearance and pre-medication, even with immunization within 1 year of outbreak
- Hyper Thyroid – Grave's Disease (presents bulging of eyes)
- Seizures – medical clearance
- Blood thinners, long term steroids – medical clearance
- Lupus/ Autoimmune Disease – medical clearance and pre-medication
- Blepharitis: **CONTAGIOUS** – medical clearance – chronic inflammation of the eyelid, usually at base of lashes. Symptoms include inflammation, irritation, itchiness.
